

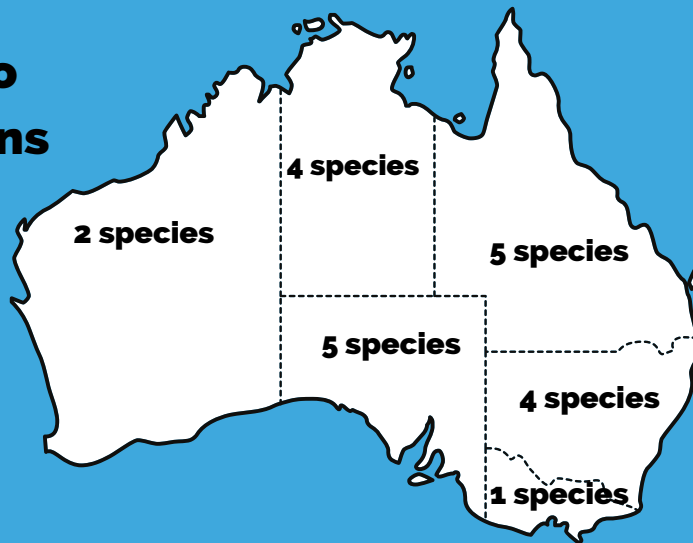


# Mozzie Month 2022

Mozzie Month is a national citizen science initiative to monitor mosquitoes across Australia from February to March.

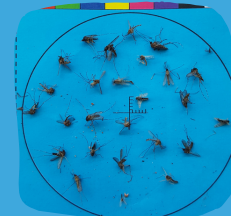
